SAR Mission Briefing: Search for a Cessna 180 (N767) that departed the Flying B Ranch on Sunday, May 25. One person on board. Was scheduled to meet girlfriend on following Tuesday, but never showed up. Estimated to have 20 gallons of fuel on board. Mission continues after many sortie hours.
