*\*Editors Note:* The WMU is a web based application that can be used for various personnel, ES, & aircraft information & scheduling functions. It is in the process of being merged with the NHQ database. Not everyone is using this system, which weakens it's functionality. We are looking into developing this tool as the primary aircraft scheduling method, etc.
